Dear Parents,

The purpose of this letter is to let you know that our classes will be performing in the 76th May Day Festival! The festivities will once again be held at The Arena on the evening of May 3rd, at 7:30 pm. The students will be performing a dance to GREASE the Musical in front of the May Day court in honor of them. This year's May Day theme is "Broadway."

There are many reasons why we choose to participate in May Day. The main reason being that the kids thoroughly enjoy doing it. Secondly, we want to show our students how proud we are of our community and its youth, and help instill this pride in them. May Day also helps raise money for our community, as well as our classroom. Please allow your child to participate in this event. Tickets go on sale April 24th at noon. They may be purchased at The Arena box office or on the Ticketmaster website. *If purchased through Ticketmaster, there are additional surcharges.* Also, tickets purchased at The Arena the day of May Day will be more expensive. If you pre-purchase tickets, you will be able to select your seats. If you wait until the event, you will not be able to choose your actual seats, only general price level. Arena ticket staff will have maps to show the different seating sections (floor, blue, and green). Parents/guardians must purchase tickets and remain at The Arena during the event.

Participating students do not need a ticket. Children 3 and under are admitted free.

- Adult \$8
- Child/Student \$4

- Arena doors open at 6:00. Students should be seated in their designated area as soon as possible.
- Parents/guardians must remain at The Arena through their child's group performance.
- Parents may pick up children from the designated seating area after their group's performance.
- Parents may gain access to this area from the upper concourse only.

Security will be in place to ensure the process moves smoothly. We do request patience in this process. School protocol and yellow card information will be used for dismissal.

Please fill out the information at the bottom of the page and return it no later than Friday. This will help inform us who will be participating in this event. We will practice our routine occasionally during recess, and exercise exploration activity time. We will send another letter home including more details as the event date nears.
