Some Fun & Helpful Ways to study for Spelling and High Frequency

- **Scrabble Letters** – Use Scrabble letter tiles to write & then read the words.
- **Crazy Words:** Put something 'crazy' (like jell-o mix, shaving cream, sand, or rice) on a cookie sheet, and have your child use his finger to 'write' then read the word.
- **Window paint** – Use window-safe crayons or markers in the tub to spell & read the words.
- **Triangle Write:** Write the words in a triangular style – like this:
